# Information

All the team of the campsite welcomes you and wishes you a great stay!

We prepared this booklet in order to make your holidays easier. We remain at your disposal for any other demand and we would be pleased to give you more information.

## Arrivals and departures

- Arrivals are **from 1pm** and departures must be **before 12am**.
- On arrival, if you have a caravan or camper van, please park your vehicle in the **yellow zebra zone** on your right before the campsite.
- Please do not park in front of the reception, as this will block access to other campers.
- For cars, there are parking spaces available in front of the reception or in a car park 100m further down towards the lake.
- When you check in, we will ask you to pay the **balance of your stay** and will give you the **bracelets** to wear during your stay.
- For those who have taken the electricity option, you will need to bring an **extension cord** and a **European plug** to connect to our terminals.
- For safety reasons, it is **not possible to recharge your electric car** on these terminals.
- We remind you that the campsite **is not equipped for emptying and filling up campervans**.



# Instructions



Wearing a wristband is compulsory on the campsite, in order to preserve your peace of mind.



Please respect the quietness of the campsite, from 10pm to 8am.



Animals are not allowed on the campsite beach or in the accommodation.



Picnics are not allowed on the campsite beach.



Visitors must check in at the reception desk and pay the applicable fee.



Electric barbecues are not permitted. Gas and charcoal barbecues are allowed but must not be done on the ground.



Recharging of electric cars is not allowed at the campsite terminals.

## Traffic

- For the safety of all, **please drive at a walking pace** within the campsite.
- Traffic in the campsite is only allowed **between 8.00 am and 10.30 pm**.
- You can then use the **car park outside the campsite**, 100m down the road.
- **Please do not park at the entrance of the campsite in the "yellow zone"**, it is only used for the registration of caravans, **risk of a fine**.
- **Caution!** When the barrier is up, please use the **side passage** (risk of head injury).

# Services

## → Bread and pastries (July/August)

You can order at the reception the day before, until 7pm. And pick up your order from 8:15am the next day.

## → Snack/Bar (July/August)

A bar is open from 4pm to 10pm and a snack from 6pm to 9pm.

## → Laundry

Washing machines and dryers are available in the **sanitary facilities**, in the pitches area.

Payment by **coins** to be inserted in the central unit next to the machines or by **credit card**.

Washing powder is included in the cleaning cycle.

**Please do not use the machines after 10pm.**

## → Beach and swimming

It is **not allowed to jump or dive** from the wall due to the shallow water.

Beware of children, swimming is **not supervised**.

At 200m from the campsite, you will find the municipal beach of Angon, on a gentle slope and supervised.



## → Bike rental



We rent bikes, you just have to book them the day before at the reception!

## → WiFi

The campsite is equipped with WiFi for a fee.

A user name and password will be given to you at the reception.

1h00 = €2   1 day = €5   1 week = €15

Access code valid for 2 devices, streaming not possible.



## → Recycling

There are sorting bins for glass and recyclables at the entrance to the campsite and containers for household waste in the campsite area.





## Forest or garden cockroaches
